Sports scholarships at Alleyn's reward excellence in multiple sporting disciplines and are available to children from all backgrounds, regardless of their financial circumstances.

Applying

Applicants wishing to be considered for a Sports Scholarship should demonstrate significant strength in at least one sport offered at Alleyn's. While there are no set specific criteria, the following guide helps parents understand the expected calibre of applicants:

- Athletic Pursuits: County standard times/distances
- Basketball: Standout club player
- Cricket: Standout club/school player, CAG, County Performance, or District level representation
- Football: Professional Academy, Academy development squad, JPL representation, or District level representation
- Hockey: Standout club/school player or District level representation
- Netball: Standout club/school player or District level representation
- Swimming: County standard times/distances
- Tennis/Racquets: Standout club/school player, County Performance (Must have LTA rating for Tennis)
- Water Polo: Standout club player

Assessment Procedure

All applicants will be invited to Alleyn's for an initial sports assessment in November / December. The primary objective of these assessment days is for pupils to have fun! This is an opportunity to showcase their talents and experience what Alleyn's has to offer.

Assessment Procedure

The initial assessment is a half-day visit where students engage in two sports of their choice. Selected candidates will be shortlisted and invited back for a second assessment day in January. The second assessment will further evaluate their main sporting competencies and assess their teamwork, problem-solving abilities, and curiosity in learning. Successful candidates will be notified at the time of offer and are expected to demonstrate a sustained commitment to sport throughout their time at the school.
